BOULDER – WHITE CLOUD WILDERNESS SUPPORT

WHEREAS, the health of Ketchum's local economy depends upon continued high-quality recreation opportunities on surrounding national forests and public lands; and

WHEREAS, the quality of life in Ketchum is reliant on the beauty and natural condition of the surrounding lands; and

WHEREAS, the City of Ketchum serves as a wilderness gateway to the Boulder-White Cloud, Pioneer, Smoky and Sawtooth Mountains; and


WHEREAS, the recreation-based economy within Blaine County generates over \$35,784,218.00 in sales tax revenue for the State of Idaho;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Ketchum hereby supports and endorses the preservation of wilderness within areas accessible from Ketchum by urging Idaho's Congressional Delegation and the United States Congress to:

Designate a 500,000 acre Boulder-White Cloud Wilderness under The Wilderness Act of 1964; and

Designate additional Wilderness area in the Pioneer and Smoky Mountains.
